

Studying Characters: **The Twits**

Learning Objective (L.O.):– To identify and discuss descriptions of characters

The task :– Identify and use a variety of **adjectives**

To succeed :–

- Find at least 8 adjectives to describe the Twits
- Use a dictionary to help you **spell correctly**

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Learning Objective (L.O.):– Becoming familiar with the term **Antonym**

The task :- Words with opposite meanings are called **antonyms**.

Year 2: Look at the list and choose the best ones to describe The Twits.

Years 3 & 4: Create a list of words that describe The Twits and find the antonym for each word

To succeed :-

- You must know what each word means, look in the dictionary to help you
- Can you think of 2 sets of antonyms yourself? For example Black and White, Hot and Cold
- Your best handwriting, with capital letters at the start of each sentence and in someone's name

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
